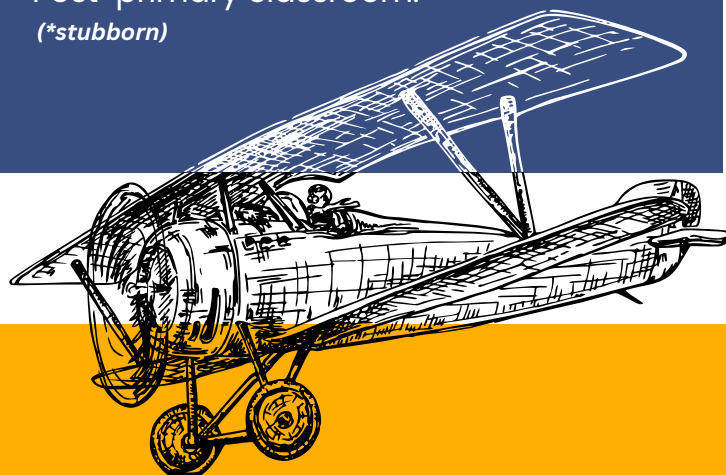


## Harry Ferguson
